

A circumnavigation of Chagford

A 4 mile walk



This walk around Chagford is slightly under 4 miles and takes in a section of the Two Moors Way, Padley Common a designated County Wildlife Site, some lovely ancient foot-paths and some magnificent views. Start by parking up in Manor Road or park in Chagford centre and walk out to Manor Road by following the signs to Fernworthy Reservoir.



**Continue walking down Manor Road passing
Manor Drive on your left**



**As the road levels out fork left towards the
playing field and club house.**



**100m or so further on fork left again
and go through a metal gate.**



Arriving at Padley Common fork right



Keep left



We are not walking up Meldon Hill so keep left again.



Across the common



Over a little stream and keep left.



At a fork keep left and walk up to a road.



When you reach the road turn left.



50m past the cattle grid turn right up the hill



Soon after the road bends left turn right and walk up the path next to the steps.



Over a little stream that might not be so little after heavy rain. Now it is an up hill walk which is quite steep in places but safer to go up than slip down hill.



When you reach the top keep left ignoring any right hand forks.



Quite soon you will arrive at the very top of the hill where you then walk out to the road and turn left.



Cross the cattle grid and take the footpath on the right a few yards further on.



Walk straight ahead.



Go through the gate next to the hole and bear left.



Passing the rock on your right keep close to the hedge on your left although paths go both left and right of the fencing and end up at the same place.



Reaching a gate go through and stay quite close to the hedge on your left but don't go through any gateways.



Walking into the woodland keep left at the oak tree.



**Follow the woodland path
through a gate and down the hill.**



When you reach the road turn right.



Then in about 150m turn left into Adley lane



Go past a house on your left and take the first left turn up a short track.



Go through the gate and straight across the field.



Keep right in the next field.



At the end of the field go over a stile and along a track to reach a road.



Keep going down the private road to reach the B3206 that leads into Chagford.



Turn left and walk towards Chagford but only as far as you can see.



**Just before you reach the first house on your right
go through a gate way and follow a path on the
other side that leads into a field.**



**Go across the field to the other
side to a gate/stile.**



Go through and out to the road and turn right



Go over the bridge and turn left through a gate signposted to Chagford Bridge. This is the Two Moors Way a very well used path.



Follow the path to go over small bridge



Quite a long way down the path it splits two ways. Here keep right and having gone through a meadow you will reach the road.



Turn left and walk over the bridge.



At the cross roads keep left and walk up the hill into Chagford.



At the next junction turn right and walk down Manor road to your car to complete the walk or go on a bit further to walk into the centre of Chagford.
